SERVICE FEES

BASIC PROFESSIONAL SERVICES OF FUNERAL DIRECTOR AND STAFF.....\$ 2,195.

This is the basic charge to each family for our professional expertise in assisting them. It includes, but is not limited to, a proportionate share of the taxes, licenses, utilities and business expenses necessary to serve the public in a professional manner. Also included in this charge is the consultation with the family, clerical and administrative services, preparation and filing of death certificate and permit (county fee's not included), consultation with the clergy, cemetery, crematory or common carrier, planning the funeral or memorial service and placement of obituary notices. There will be an additional charge for the direction and supervision of each service requested or required. This fee is for our basic services and overhead and will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. (This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremations, immediate burials and forwarding or receiving of remains.)

EMBALMING.....\$ 590.

Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial.

Embalming is a chemical process which provides temporary preservation of the body and eliminates certain health hazards. A person licensed by the state of California must complete this procedure.

OTHER PREPARATION OF THE BODY

- 1. Dressing, cosmetizing, and casketing of embalmed remains \$390.
- 2. Sanitation, dressing, placement in casket/container of un-embalmed remains ... (closed casket) \$290.
- 3. *Private Family View* includes: Sanitation, setting features for viewing of un-embalmed remains, dressing, use of small room for 30 minutes (Designed for Immediate Family Only-10 people max.)... \$395.
- 4. Post autopsy / organ donor - care and repair \$380.
- 5. Restoration, when necessary, per hour..... \$185.

FUNERAL DIRECTING SERVICES AND USE OF FACILITIES AND EQUIPMENT

Use of facilities and staff for funeral or memorial service at our mortuary chapel

During normal business hours Monday thru Friday \$ 1,195.

Use of equipment and staff for funeral or memorial service at a local church or hall

During normal business hours Monday thru Friday..... \$ 1,085.

Use of facilities and staff for visitation. During normal business hours, Monday thru Friday, 1:00 P.M. to 4:00 P.M. (in small viewing room or in chapel if available) \$ 395.

Equipment and staff for weekend, holiday, or evening visitation.....(add) \$ 250.

Equipment and staff for weekend, holiday, or evening service at mortuary or offsite...(add) \$ 480.
(Holiday services only scheduled if staff available.)

Professional Staff Fee – per hour..... \$ 100.

Equipment and staff for grave-side services only..... \$ 495.

Refrigeration charge for un-embalmed remains - per day \$ 85.

Priority Rush Charge will be added to any package where burial or cremation is requested to be completed in less than 72 hours..... (not all requests may be possible) Priority Fee... \$ 350.

FORWARDING REMAINS TO ANOTHER FUNERAL HOME..... \$2,795.

Our charge includes: basic services of funeral director and administrative staff, a proportionate share of overhead costs, local transfer of decedent to funeral home, obtaining and completing Death Certificate, embalming or other preparation of remains, combo/shipping tray, local filing fee, phone/faxing and transportation to Oakland or San Francisco airport. This charge does not include viewing, visitation, rites or ceremonies prior to forwarding the body or cash advance items except local filing fee.

RECEIVING OF REMAINS FROM ANOTHER FUNERAL HOME..... \$2,350.

Our charge includes: basic services of funeral director and staff, a proportionate share of overhead costs, care of decedent, local transportation of remains to funeral home, Van delivery to local cemetery for burial. This charge does not include viewing, visitation, rites, ceremonies, or cash advance items.

IMMEDIATE BURIAL.....(without ceremony or family present)..... Range \$ 2,300. to \$ 2,995.

Our charge for an immediate burial includes: basic services of funeral director and staff, a proportionate share of overhead costs, local transfer of decedent, 3 days refrigeration, obtaining death certification, dressing un-embalmed decedent, casketing, and van transportation to local cemetery. This does not include visitation, rites or ceremonies, cash advance items, cemetery charges or expenses or casket unless otherwise indicated.

- a. Immediate burial with casket provided by purchaser \$ 2,300.
- b. Immediate burial with a minimum casket provided by our funeral home..... \$ 2,995.
- c. Immediate burial with casket selected from our funeral home.....\$ 2,300. + Cost of Casket

DIRECT CREMATION... (urns, alternative containers, cash advances and sales tax are not included) \$ 2,250.

Our charge for a direct cremation (without ceremony) includes: the basic services of funeral director and staff for obtaining, completing, and filing legal documents, proportionate share of overhead costs, 24 hour local transfer of decedent to funeral home from healthcare facility or residence, refrigeration (72 hours) and the cremation at our crematory. This discounted package will provide cremated remains available for return in approximately seven (7) days from date of arrangement. Priority handling of the cremation is available for an additional fee.

If you want to arrange a direct cremation you can use an alternative container. Alternative containers encase the body and can be made of material like fiberboard and composition materials. The alternative containers we provide are constructed of wood and/or cardboard material.
